

# #key4 freedom

**As we celebrate our freedom at the Seder, we remind ourselves of those in our own country whose freedom is restricted.**

At the Seder table, we celebrate and remember our own hard-earned freedom. However, the policy of indefinite immigration detention means that there are still thousands of people in our own country fighting for theirs.

The UK is the only country in the EU with no upper time limit on how long asylum seekers can be detained. A parliamentary cross-party report labelled indefinite detention "expensive, ineffective and unjust" but still every year over 30,000 people go through the detention system.

**This Pesach, we ask you to put a key on your Seder plate and explain to people why you are doing this.**

**Help raise awareness of this story of captivity still taking place around us.**
